

WHEREAS, currently there is pending Senate Bill 1730 and General Assembly Bill 2478 which would require all public officers and employees to reside in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the bill requires every person holding an office, employment or position to reside within the State of New Jersey. Every person who, on the effective date of this bill, does not have his or her principal residence in this State but holds such an office, employment or position will have two years and six months from that effective date to comply with the residency requirement; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the City of Paterson wishes to support Senate Bill 1730 and General Assembly Bill 2478 and urges passage of same.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Municipal Council of the City of Paterson hereby supports Senate Bill 1730 and General Assembly Bill 2478.




